

CALL FOR PAPERS

The Institute of Objective Studies (IOS), which was established in New Delhi in 1986, is celebrating the silver jubilee of its establishment. These celebrations shall continue for a full year. The Silver Jubilee year of the Institute was inaugurated with an International Conference on Peace, Justice and Development on 15 April, 2011 in New Delhi and shall end with another International Conference which shall be held, Insha Allah, in 2012 H. The Institute plans to hold a number of programs to celebrate its Silver Jubilee. These programs include exhibitions, essay competitions and international conferences. Three of these have already been held and many more shall be held in major cities all over India.

Organization of International Conferences constitutes an important part of these programs. The scholars including Professors at the university departments or research institutes and research scholars all over the world are invited to contribute papers for these conferences. Although Institute is not in a position any honorarium to scholars, it shall be pleased to provide them economy class air fare to foreign scholars and second class AC chair car railway fare to domestic scholars from their normal place of residence to the venue of the conference and back through the most direct route. In addition, the scholars shall be the guests of the Institute during the conference period and their boarding and lodging expenses shall be paid by it. The papers, intended to be presented should follow the following format:

- The papers should be typed on A 4 size papers, leaving appropriate margins on both sides.
- The papers should be typed using New Roman Font with font size 12.
- The text of the Paper should be separated by a cover page having title, Position and affiliation of the author(s). the conference at which it is to be presented.
- The papers should not exceed 30 type written pages or 30,000 words whichever is less.
- The authors should supply tables, diagrams, formulae, and equations used in the paper on a separate sheet of paper. The text should clearly indicate their place of insertion.
- The style followed in the paper should be uniform throughout. It is strongly suggested that authors use University of Chicago Style Manual. However, it is not mandatory.

- All submitted papers shall be subject to review by a technical committee appointed by the Chairman of the Institute. Only the papers selected by the technical committee shall be accepted for presentation at the conferences.
- In order to allow maximum numbers of scholars to participate in the conference, each scholar will be given only 10 to 15 minutes for making presentations. The authors are requested to come prepared with a summary or an Abstract which could be presented within the time allocated to them.
- A paper could be submitted by more than one scholar. If a joint paper, prepared by more than one scholar is selected by the technical committee for presentation at the conference, only the senior author will be invited to the conference. In such a case, the privileges extended by the Institute shall also be confined to a single person only.
- A paper intended for an IOS conference should not have been presented elsewhere.
- Only original and unpublished writings shall be considered by the technical committee for presentation at the conference
- The copy right of all papers submitted at an IOS conference shall vest with the Institute, which reserves its right to publish these papers either in the form of a book or a proceeding at a later date, as it may deem fit.
- All papers, intended for any IOS conference should reach IOS at least one month before the date of the conference.
