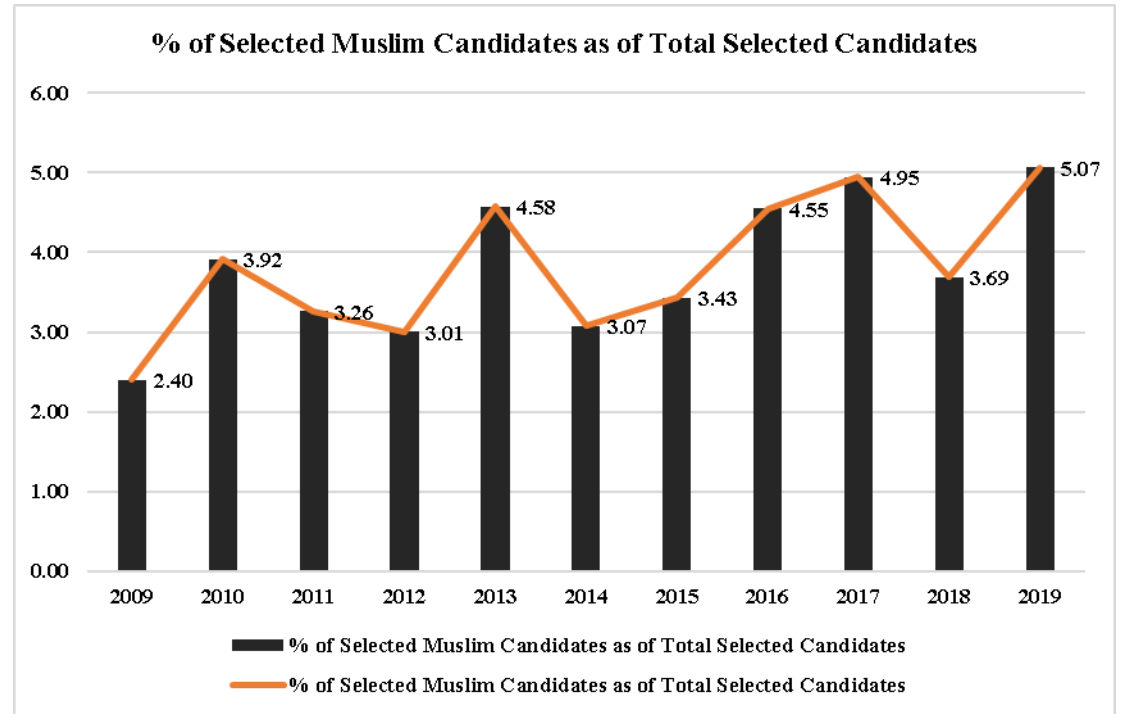

Percentage of selected Muslim Female Candidates was just 9.7% in 2010 but it became as high as 26.5% in 2017 but again it came down to 14.3% in latest results of 2019.

Whereas, Total selected Muslim Candidates has gone up from 3.97% in 2010 to now 5.07% in 2019.

We should not compare the Percentage of selected Muslim Candidates with the Percentage of Muslim Population in India, rather we should compare with Percentage of Eligible Educated Muslim Population for IAS, UPSC in India.
