Short Note on 40 Countries with Highest Military Expenditure 2019 and Armed Forces as % of Total Labor Force

Table 1 below shows that Total Military Expenditure as % of World Share in 2019 that of Top 5 (including India with Rank 3 in 2019 spending 71.1 \$\frac{1}{2}\$ billion with 3.7% of World Share), USA is on Top (Rank 1) with the Highest Military Expenditure (732 \$\frac{1}{2}\$ billion with 38% of World Share) and Denmark with Lowest Rank 40 (spending 4.6 \$\frac{1}{2}\$ billion with 0.2% of World Share), Top 10 and Top 15 countries is 62%, 75% and 81% respectively. Where as Armed Forces Personnel as % of Total Labor Force for these Top 15 countries is generally less than 1% except for Israel (more than 4%), Russia and Saudi Arabia nearly 2% and Italy and France nearly 1% for 2017 and 2018.

Total Highest Military Expenditure of all 9 Muslim Countries in 2019 (out of these 40 Countries with the Highest Military Expenditure 1771 \$billion with 92% of World Share in 2019) is 145.1 \$billion with 7.6% of World Share.
