Short Note on Percentage of Total Income of Madhya Pradesh Waqf Board from 2008-09 to 2019-20

Table 1 shows actual numbers of Total Income from (i) Govt Grant, (ii) Chanda Nigrani and (iii) Other Resources of MP Waqf Board from 2008-09 to 2019-20. In Table 2, Percentages of (i) Govt Grant, (ii) Chanda Nigrani and (iii) Other Resources as Percentage of Total Income show that the Percentage of Govt Grant was lowest (33%) in 2017-18, highest (62.5%) in 2019-20, Chanda Nigrani being lowest (24.9%) in 2019-20 and highest (65.8%) in 2017-18. Whereas, income from Other Sources was lowest (0.9%) in 2017-18 and highest (26.2%) in 2012-13.

It must be analysed that why Chanda Nigrani has gone down from highest (65.8%) in 2017-18 to lowest (24.9%) in 2019-20. Steps should be taken to boost it.
