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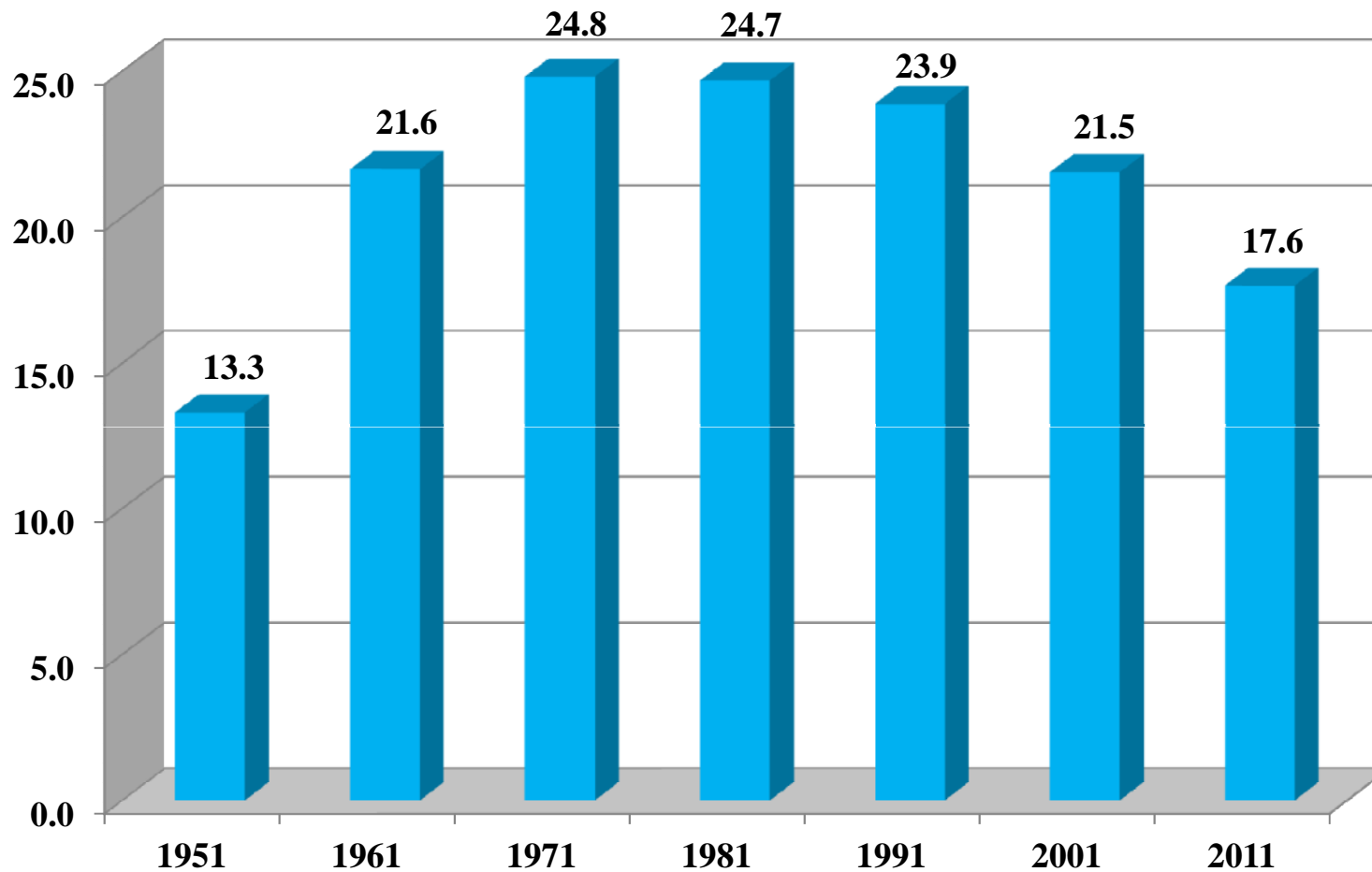

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## Decadal Population Growth Rates, India: 1951-2011



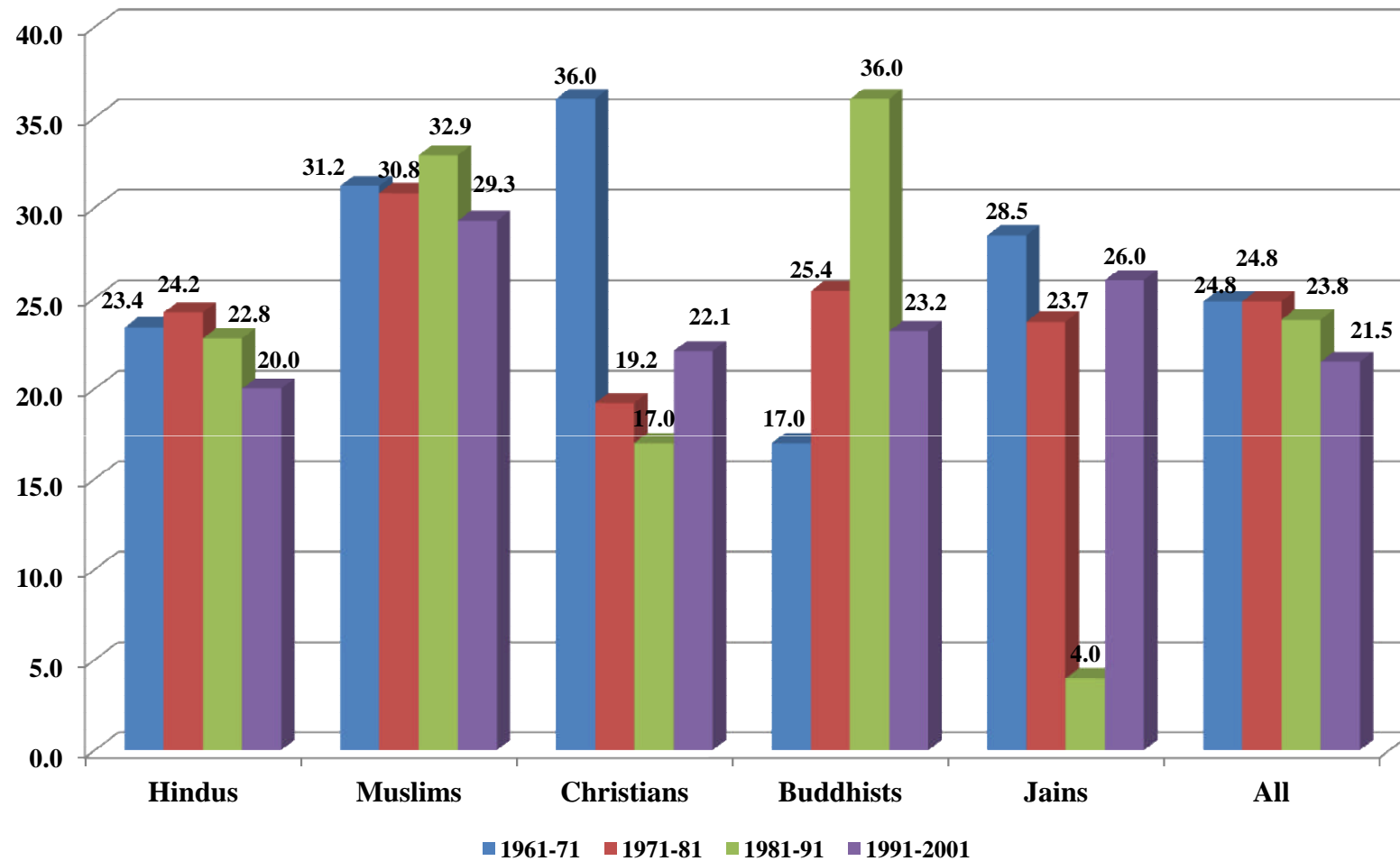
