

Mosques through the Ages (Started From 2011)
Four Oldest Mosques of Malaysia

It is the oldest mosque in Malaysia which is still standing, usable and intact in the original condition. The vernacular architecture design of the KLOM strongly resembles the traditional Malay architecture. The current location of the KLOM is in the district of Nilam Puri, the Islamic academic district of Kelantan. This mosque was first built around 14 hundred and it still serves the local people as a place for worship. The KLOM is regarded as a living museum, which continues to attract the researchers, architecture students, Muslim faithful, and historian to visit this legendary mosque to explore its vast history and knowledge which lies within. The KLOM design contains all the classical elements of the traditional Malay architecture with elevated raised floor, three-layered roof and carved supporting columns.

The Peringggit Mosque in Malacca is another oldest mosque in Malaysia which is still being used. The mosque is believed to have been constructed during the Portuguese colonial era and it was built using mud taken from a nearby river. Later during the Dutch era, the mosque was rebuilt. At that time, the Dutch administration gave freedom to the residents of Malacca to practice their own religion and allowed places of worship to be established. Since then, this mosque has been renovated and now remains strong and beautiful with its quality original frame structure. The Peringggit Mosque is different from the other mosques in Malacca. The Peringggit Mosque's pulpit is unique because it is a combination of two types of building materials, namely wood and stone.

The mosque was originally built around the year 1720-728. It underwent renovation in 1892. The architectural design of the mosque is a cross between local Malay, Sumatera, and Sini. The minaret, ablution pool and entrance arch were built at the same time with the main building. The minaret resembles a pagoda. An ancient cemetery lies next to the mosque where some notable preachers and missionaries are buried.

The mosque was built in 1728 and it used to be the State mosque of Malacca before the establishment of Al Azim Mosque in 1990. The original mosque structure was made entirely of timber bought from Kalimantan, Dutch East India Company. It had since undergone several renovations and restorations. The mosque consists of Javanese culture components. It features a triple-tiered pyramidal roof and a square base. It is one of the few mosques in Malaysia which has a pagoda in place of a minaret. The interior is a mixture of Malay, Chinese and Indonesian elements.
