Percentage of Muslim Candidates Selected out of Total Candidates Selected in Civil Services

It has been observed that the average percentage of Muslim candidates selected out of total candidates selected in Civil Services in past six years, that is, **from 2010 to 2015 has gone down to 3.04 percent (Table 1 below)** as compared to the average percentage of Muslim candidates selected out of total candidates selected in Civil Services **from 1990 to 2009 which was 3.95 percent**. Though there is more awareness for appearing into Civil Service Examination because more efforts are made by the responsible persons of Muslim community and NGOs.

It is really a matter of concern. Responsible persons of Muslim community have to sit and rethink that how things can be improved and can turn this deterioration into increase.
