# Numbers and Percentages of Males-Females Selected in UPSC (Civil Services Examination) – 2024 and 2025

Table 1 (below) shows that Numbers and Percentages for Males are 659 (decreased to 68.79%) and Females are 299 (increased to 31.21%) out of 958 Total selected Candidates in 2025 in UPSC (CSE) which was 725 (71.85%) for Males and 284 (28.15%) for Females out of 1009 Total selected Candidates in 2024 in UPSC (CSE) (Table 2).

Table 1 (below) shows that Numbers and Percentages for Muslims increased to 53 (5.25% of Total 958 selected Candidates) whereas Muslim Males are 38 (5.53% of Total 659 Males selected) and Muslim Females are 15 (5.28% of Total 299 Females selected) out of 958 Total selected candidates in 2025 in UPSC (CSE) which was 27 (2.68% of Total 1009 selected Candidates) for Muslim Males were 18 (2.48% of Total 725 selected Males) and Muslim Females were 9 (3.17% out of 264 Total Females selected candidates) in 2024 in UPSC (CSE) - Table 2.
