Hindu Temple Properties

Similarly, the Andhra Pradesh government oversees and appoints the head of the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD), which manages the Tirupati Temple.

Tamil Nadu:

The state's HR&CE department manages temples, including finances and appointments, as well as owning a significant amount of temple land.

Andhra Pradesh:

The state controls the TTD, which manages the Tirupati Temple, and appoints its head.

Jammu and Kashmir:

The state enacted the Jammu and Kashmir Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Act, 1988, specifically for managing the Vaishno Devi Shrine.

Other States:

Many other states have laws that allow government control over temple administration, ensuring accountability and potentially utilizing temple revenue for social welfare initiatives.

Hindu Temples and their associated Endowments (Properties) in India

In India, Hindu Temples and their associated Endowments (Properties) are managed in various ways, with some states exerting significant control through Temple Boards or other state-run entities. Land ownership of temple properties varies considerably across states. Some states, like Tamil Nadu, have substantial temple-owned land, while others have less.

State-wise Overview of Temple Properties:

- Tamil Nadu: Known for extensive temple land ownership, with the Tamil Nadu Temple Trust owning over 478,000 acres.
- Andhra Pradesh: Has a significant amount of land under Hindu endowments, estimated at 4 lakh acres.
- Telangana: Hindu endowments control 87,000 acres of land, according to the CAG.
- Odisha: 13 temples are reported to control 12,776 acres, as per the CAG.
- Gujarat: Akshardham, a major Hindu temple and organization, is located in the state capital.
- Uttar Pradesh: Notable temples like Kashi Vishwanath Temple in Varanasi and Ram Mandir in Ayodhya are located in this state.
- Uttarakhand: Kedarnath Temple, one of the 12 Jyotirlingas, is situated in the Garhwal region.
- Other states: Temples like Sabarimala (Kerala), Meenakshi Temple (Tamil Nadu), and the Jagannath Temple (Odisha) are significant pilgrimage sites with associated properties.
